## Weather Conditions and Plant Development

After an exceptionally warm and dry April, May was very cool and there was enough rain, especially in the second half of the month. Therefore, the hops could not keep up with the fast growth pace it reached in April. In the beginning of June, hop development was on an average basis. In the first half of June, the hops could grow well. The water reserve in the soil is sufficient for the time being. However, the most important phases of development are yet to come.

In the first weeks of June, some parts of the Hallertau were affected by hail storms. Recently, there were also some minor hail damages in Tettnang and Elbe-Saale. We do not expect this to have an impact on the overall crop.


So far, there have not been any remarkable problems with pests or diseases.



### German Hop Acreage Increases by 300 ha in 2019

According to official data, total hop acreage in Germany has risen by approx. 300 ha (+ 1.4%) and is around 20,400 ha now. Of these, 19,773 ha are mature hops with the rest being baby hops. The increases are distributed amongst all German hop growing regions.

Major developments of varieties can be summarised as follows:

- After several years of major increases, the current increase of Herkules was comparatively moderate (+3.9%).
- All other high alpha varieties are decreasing.
- Varieties Perle (+4.8%) and Hallertauer Tradition (+ 2.2%) increased significantly after several years of stagnation.
- Acreage of most flavor varieties is decreasing slightly.
