
## **GREEN BULLET**

New Zealand

**Origin:** New Zealand. A high-alpha hopbred from open cross-pollination of Smoothcone, Green Bullet was first released in 1972. As with many New Zealand varieties, it possesses a level of aromatic oils unusual for high-alpha varieties bred in this era.

**Usage:** While Green Bullet was originally bred for bittering power, its pleasingly mellow and resinous oil profile lends itself well to late




additions in English ale styles. It is regarded as a workhorse in its native New Zealand and is widely used there.

**Aroma & Flavor Characteristics:** Moderately intense with a distinct floral, resinous character reminiscent of Styrian Goldings and layered with hints of musky Southern Hemisphere fruit.
