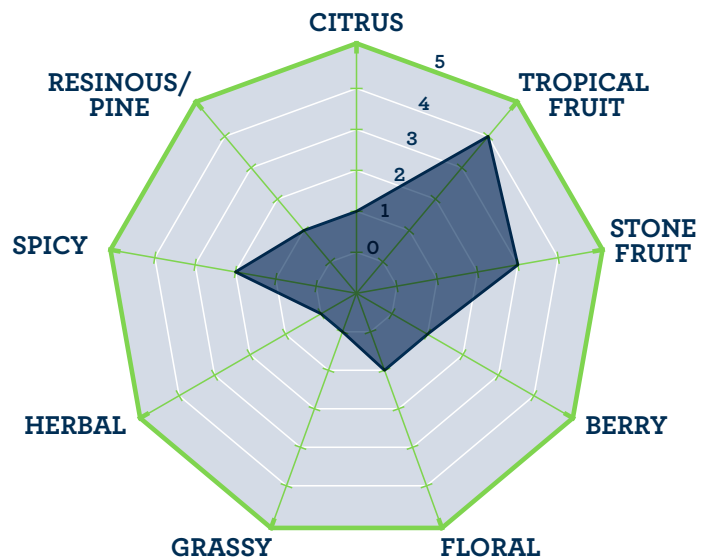

Origin: USA. Zappa™ is a native, North American, *Humulus lupulus* variety, *neomexicanus*, recovered from the wild in New Mexico. Named after Frank Zappa, in collaboration with the Zappa family, this hop is as counterculture as the musician himself.

Usage: Aroma, whirlpool, and dry hopping for any hop- or complementary fruit-forward style:

hazy or milkshake IPA, fruited sour, pale ale, American strong ale, and wild or mixed-fermentation beers.



Aroma & Flavor Characteristics: Spicy with strong notes of tropical fruit (mango, passion fruit), citrus, and pine. Additional descriptors include savory, mint, and Fruity Pebbles™.
